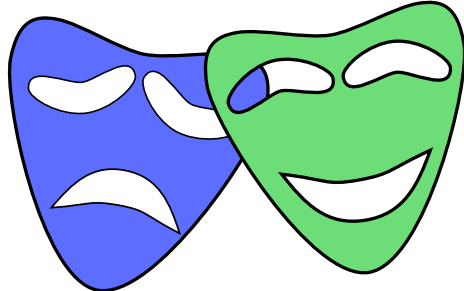
Artist Profile

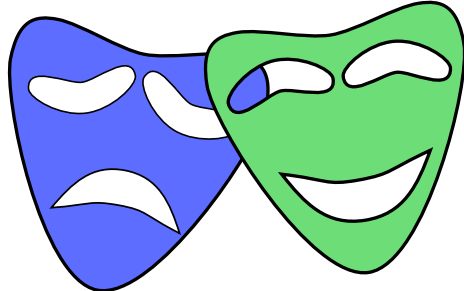
Artist Profile
